ARTICLE 24 – LABOR-MANAGEMENT COUNCIL

24.1 Purpose and Scope of Authority. The University and the Union will maintain a Labor-Management Council to provide a forum for communication between the parties and to promote constructive labor-management relations. Council meetings will be used for discussions and shared problem-solving only; the Council shall have no authority to conduct any negotiations or modify the provisions of this Agreement.

24.2 Council Composition. The Labor-Management Council will consist of the Union President plus three (3) faculty members selected by the Union, the ~~Associate Vice President~~ ^{Assistant Vice President} for Faculty Affairs-Relations plus three (3) representatives selected by the Office of the Provost.
