- COVID-19 response: we're working with the administration. Issues:
 - Cancelled academic travel: Reimbursement for committed expenses? And will the event still count as a Category B?
 - Allow roll-over of development funds to next year for those who had had work accepted, but then couldn't go?
 - Spring teaching: When will we know what we're doing? Workload allocations if we do need to transfer FTF classes to online?

- Development funds: tighten up rules about allowed usage?
 - Many NTTs (and maybe T/TTs as well?) are purchasing teaching supplies (markers, whiteboards, textbooks, lab equipment, software). The current guidelines for NTTs allow this.
- UNIV 101: mostly taught by advisors, not faculty. This is contrary to the CBA. But how hard do we want to push on this issue?
 - Concern #1: faculty may not even *want* to teach UNIV 101; we could end up with no one wanting to teach the class at all.
 - Concern #2: pushing on this issue might lead to grad student teaching also being denied.

 - Such data *could* be made available, but currently is not. Is there a desire for it?
