- Summary of accomplishments last meeting (5/7/19)
 - Interfolio software for review, promotion, and tenure will go live in August 2019. The Provost's office will follow up to see if we can try out the software.
 - The Provost will review funded NTT faculty development requests to see if there should be more specific criteria. LMC will discuss this at an upcoming meeting.
 - LMC recommended that Dr. Kurtz return to the Interdisciplinary Program Workgroup to create one unified proposed change to CBA Article 12 that would cover interdisciplinary program directors, parallel to what is already included for department chairs. It will include director terms, election procedures, and summer compensation, among other things. This is an effort to eliminate too much variation among programs. There will be a proposal to remove what is/will be included in the CBA from policy (e.g., CWUP 5-60 on chairs).
 - Prior to the date when faculty files are due to the dean's office, a faculty file can be unlocked at the request/discretion of the department chair. This may be for a faculty member to add additional materials or so that the chair or DPC can submit revised letters. After it leaves the department, nothing new can be added (except rebuttals to correct errors of fact, as provided by the CBA).
